



# Volunteer Guides Course

The Israel Museum, Jerusalem  
Starting in November 2009

The program is designed to train guides for the Museum's galleries (bilingual in Hebrew and English – additional languages an asset). The course will be led by curators and lecturers from a variety of disciplines.

The program includes eight months of study, twice weekly.

## Admission requirements:

- Hebrew and English proficiency (mother-tongue level)
  - Residence in or near Jerusalem
- Background in art and archaeology preferred
- Experience working with people
  - Computer literacy

Participants must commit to guiding Museum visitors on a volunteer basis for at least three years following the end of the course.

Program fee: NIS 2,500 (including yearlong Museum membership)
